

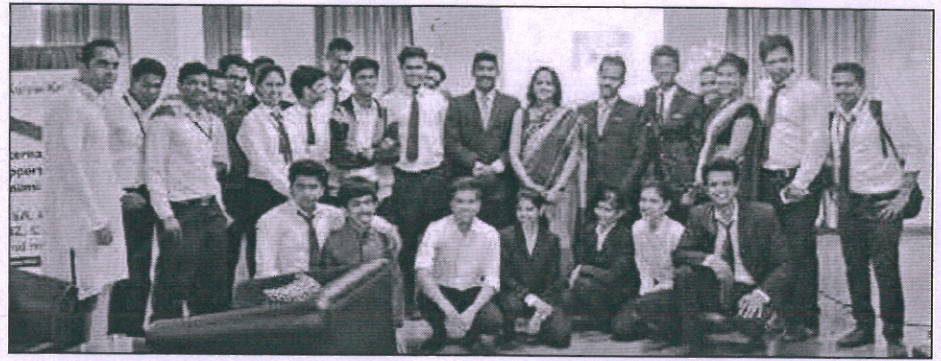
AISSMS CHMCT students hold 'Lobby blast'
