NSS ACTIVITIES FOR YEAR – 2021-22

At AISSMS CHMCT Pune various initiatives, and community service activities undertaken by NSS volunteers during the year 2021-22.

NSS activities covered a wide range of social and community service initiatives, including health camps, environmental projects, Marathi Bhasha Phandharwara, and Swachhta Abhiyan and awareness programs on social issues.

Swachhta Pakhwada, 1st August to 15th August, 2021 was conducted to spread awareness among the students about maintaining cleanliness and hygiene in the campus.

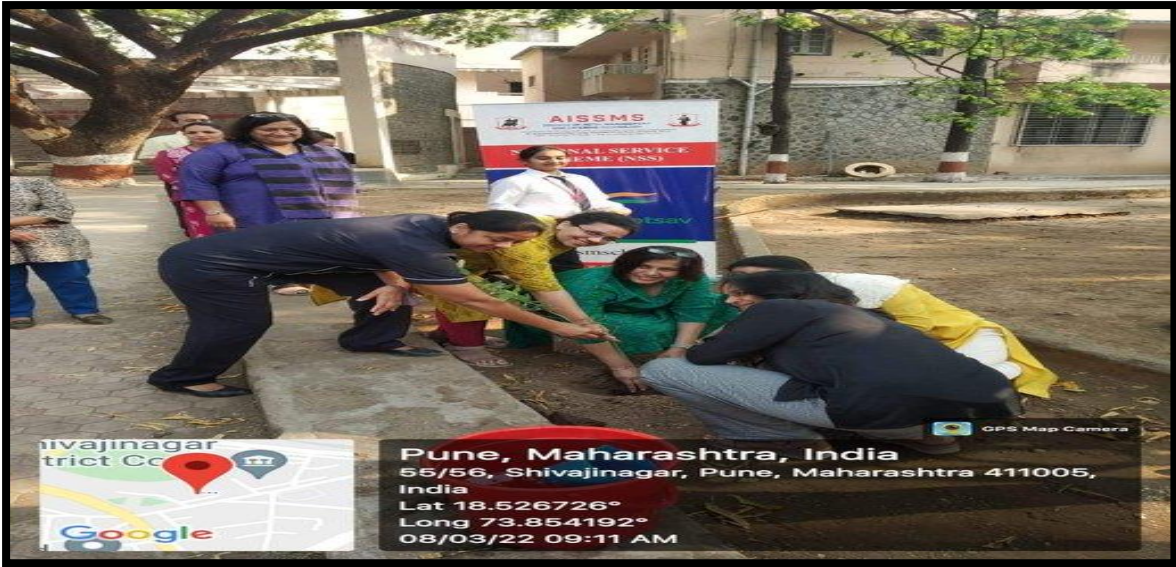
