EXAMINATION NOTICE FOR PHOTOCOPY AND REVALUATION

The Students of F.Y. B.Sc.HS, S.Y. B.Sc.HS & T.Y. B.Sc.HS may apply for Photocopy (ies) & Revaluation for examination held in May-June 2024. They should fill the online application forms from <u>01/08/2024 to 05/08/2024 till 5pm</u>. Online application form is available on the College Examination Department software: <u>student.aissmschmctapps.in/dashboard</u> student.

Note: -

Students May be eligible to apply for revaluation of his/her answer-book/s of the theory papers of the term end examination, subject to the following conditions:

- A candidate may apply for revaluation of 50% of heads of passing in theory subjects or maximum three heads of passing in theory subject/s whichever is less, at the examination in which he/she has appeared at the said College Examination.
- 2. The revaluation of the answer book/s, however, shall not be permitted in respect of scripts of Practical Examination / Team Work / Internal Assessment / Sessional Marks / Dissertation / online examination etc.
- 3. A candidate applying for revaluation shall note that the result of the revaluation of his/her answer-book/s of the theory paper/s shall be binding on him/her and that he/she shall accept the revised marks obtained in his/her theory papers after revaluation.
- 4. The candidate shall pay **Rs.500/- per subject** for Photocopy & Revaluation.
- 5. The result of revaluation will be displayed online within 15 days after last date of application.
- 6. No revaluation applications would be entertained after due date & time.
