NSS ACTIVITIES FOR YEAR – 2024-25

The motto of NSS is "Not Me, But You," reflecting the spirit of selfless service to the community.

At AISSMS CHMCT Pune various initiatives, and community service activities undertaken by NSS volunteers during the year 2024-25.

World Environmental Day - As per the circular received from SPPU, AICTE, DTE, Directorate of NSS, AISSMS CHMCT's NSS unit took initiative to address critical environmental challenges. Under the theme, "Our land, our future", the college planted shrubs of Vidya and papaya tree in the college campus. To contribute to this global initiative, the institute during the first year Bsc Hs student's orientation program welcomed them by giving the saplings, which were planted by the students, along with the NSS team, parents and the Principal planted in the campus. Awareness about paperless initiative, plastic free campus and importance of Food waste reduction was also addressed during the orientation program. One of our student, Bhavesh Burkunde also participated in the ECA competition where he shared a story based on understanding the importance of environment.

The theme selected for this year's **International Day of Yoga 2024** was Yoga for Self and Society." During the International Yoga Day celebration participants learnt to perform Meditation, Surya Namaskar, Pranayama, and various Asanas as explained by the instructor. The session commenced at 8.30 am, and was followed with healthy refreshments for all yoga participants.

Ashadi Wari - The Nivdunga Vithoba Mandir and Palkhi Vithoba Mandir in Pune's old city host the palkhis of the Pandharpur Wari for a day and two nights. The palkhi of Sant Tukaram Maharaj commenced its journey from Dehu today (June 28), while that of Sant Dnyaneshwar Maharaj, from Alandi on June 29th 2024. The NSS volunteers took initiative to reach out to warkaris and distributed snacks. This way they contributed towards the community for a noble cause.

As per the circular received from SPPU, regarding "Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam" project, the information was passed amongst the students of AISSMS CHMCT. The students were motivated to plant saplings in the community, take care of the saplings and help towards environment sustainability. The students took initiative and planted various saplings. Some of them were Allspice, Green chilies, baby radish, Baby carrot Brussels Sprouts, Lettuce, Tomato, Rose, curry leaves, Rosemary, Parsley, Celery, etc.

Plastic Waste management - A guest lecture was organized for the students under the subject Community engagement and service and NSS. The session was conducted by Mrs. Mita Banerjee who is a part of support group and is involved with multiple NGO s for community engagement and services. She mentioned about the impact of plastic waste to water bodies, water animals, soil, and to the air and is responsible for water pollution, soil pollution and air pollution. The only solution to all the problems is to apply 3 R steps: Reduce, Reuse, and Refuse of plastic. The major emphasis was given to the segregation of plastic at all the sources and sending it for recycling. The students took an oath, 'My waste, and my responsibility'. The students have taken up the responsibility of collecting the plastic waste and then give it to Rudra Environmental solutions for further recycling. The plastic waste includes Food Item bags, PET bottles, Detergent bags, Plastic flowers, Tooth paste, tooth brush, Plastic brooms, plastic wrappers, shower curtains, etc.

The college has made a provision to collect waste in college. This initiative was a big step towards environment conservation.

As per the instruction from SPPU, a **medical check-up camp** was organized for AISSMS CHMCT first year FYBBA students on 19th July, 2024. Dr. Sagar Thorat and his team checked 19 of our students based on diet, sports, habits, height, weight, exercise, BP, pulse, etc. The remuneration of Rs. 30/- per students was given to Dr. Sagar.

- Students were advised based on their health condition by the doctor and were guided for further fitness.

As per the instruction from SPPU, a medical check-up camp was organized for AISSMS CHMCT first year Bsc HS students on 5th, 8th July, 2024. Dr. Sagar Thorat and his team checked 112 of our students based on diet, sports, habits, height, weight, exercise, BP, pulse, etc. The remuneration of Rs. 30/- per students was given to Dr. Sagar.

- Students were advised based on their health condition by the doctor and were guided for further fitness.

NSS team also did tree plantation at Anandham old age home.

Har Ghar Tiranga - As per the circular received from SPPU, All the students, faculty and non-teaching staff of AISSMS CHMCT uploaded their selfie with Tiranga on the national portal. Most of them acquired the e- certificate. Eco friendly flags were distributed, which had Tulsi seeds, and can be planted after the event. Flag hoisting was attended by the students, teaching and non-teaching staff at SSPMS ground. Some of the students also visited SOFOSH-

Srivatsa, to engage and participated with kids for Independence Day celebrations. Independence day pledge was taken by all during this event.

A medical check-up camp was organized for AISSMS CHMCT Non-teaching staff, as well as the AISSM society workers on 14th August 2024. This was a welfare activity conducted by the NSS Unit for the medical fitness of the working staff. A total of 72 staff benefitted under this medical camp. Following check-ups were done: Blood Pressure, Random Sugar, Dental check-up, Height and weight. The consultation was given by the team of Doctors for the ailment. Also the team of Symbiosis distributed discount coupons for medical services at their campus for the non-teaching staff.

A DAAN UTSAV was organized as an activity under the subject Community Engagement and services, also NSS by the students of SYBSC HS. Under this initiative, donation appeal was made to all the staff, non-teaching and the students of the institute. Donations were collected in the form of old cloths in good condition, Grocery items, Ek Mutthi Annaj, Stationary, Biscuits, Toys, etc. from the period of 5th August till 9th August 2024. In the following week, this donation was donated to the following NGO: Matoshree- an old age home in Karve nagar, Pune and Rainbow Homes in Market yard Pune.

The students of sybsc hs distributed this DAAN to the old people at Matoshree, spent quality time with them, enquiring about their life state.

The second batch of students attended at Rainbow Homes, an NGO which helps underprivileged children. They also had a small activity with the kids. This activity was conducted in coordination with BHUMI Foundation.

As per the instruction from SPPU, a **medical check-up** camp was organized for AISSMS CHMCT first year FYBHMCT students on 5th September, 2024. Dr. Sagar Thorat and his team checked 34 of our students based on diet, sports, habits, height, weight, exercise, BP, pulse, etc. The remuneration of Rs. 30/- per students was given to Dr. Sagar.

Victim Compensation - As per the circular received from Pune Jilha Vidhi Seva Pradhikaran, a session was organized on 23rd September, 2024 for all the students of AISSMS CHMCT. The objective of the session was to make students aware who is a Victim. A victim is someone who has experienced loss or injury due to an act or omission that the accused is charged with. This can include physical or mental injury, emotional suffering, economic loss, or a substantial impairment of their fundamental rights. Another objective was to spread the awareness about

the Victim Compensation Scheme and the legal rights of a Victim. Preliminary discussion was done with the Principal of the institute, Admin head, NSS PO, SDO and the Principal District and Sessions Judge, Pune. The session started with Mrs. Sonal Patil who addressed students about various schemes which are available for a victim under the law. The session was then taken over by Shri. Mahendra Mahajan/ Principal District and Sessions Judge, Pune. He informed students that they should be vigilant and report the cases as there are laws to protect. Further a presentation was given on laws The provisions relating to compensation to victims of crime are contained in sections 357, 357(1), 357 (2), 357 (3), 357A, 358, 359 and 250 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973. Article 14 and 21 of the Constitution of India encompasses within its fold safeguards to victims of crime.

A MoU is signed with AISSMSCHMCT and DLSA. Ms Arbina Shaikh our NSS volunteer played a key role in restoring Andhesgaon village girl Tulsi Jadhav vision, who was operated at NIO with support of DLSA. The operation was fully funded under the scheme of Charitable Hospital scheme as per Maharashtra Public Trust Act 1950 for economically weaker patients.

As per the circular received from SPPU and AICTE, NSS team and faculty of AISSMS CHMCT conducted a **cleaning drive** at a Heritage site in Pune, "Shaniwar Wada". The objective of this drive was contributing to the goal of Garbage free India. The permission to clean the Heritage site was granted by ASI. The campaign aims to promote cleanliness and hygiene across India and is being celebrated from 14th September to 1st October, 2024 with the theme of Swabhav Swachhata Sanskaar Swachhata. Sampurna Swachhata through Shramdaan started with the students cleaning the tourist site and also a heritage site. The students collected garbage, plastic waste from Shaniwar wada and properly disposed at the designated place allotted by PMC. There were about 120 volunteers who started cleaning drive at 7:30 am on 1st October, 2024.

In the view of spreading the awareness about Constitution and its features amongst Millennial, department of Youth Affairs planned nationwide campaign through NSS. Under this campaign, AISSMS College of Hotel Management & Catering Technology, Pune conducted activities like Pledge taking, placing the Preamble in various prime areas of the institute.

It is directed to say that Govt. of India has declared 15th November, the birth anniversary of Bhagwan Birsa Munda, the legendary freedom fighter and tribal leader of the country. To celebrate the JJDG (Jan Jatiya Gaurav Diwas) 2024 fittingly, so as to make the events one of commemoration of the tribal freedom fighters and their contributions to the freedom movement

as well as of public celebrations of the tribal communities to Indian Society and heritage in general, which will lead to empowerment of tribes and inclusive development.

In the view of spreading the awareness about Minority Rights, an Essay making and Drawing competition was held at AISSMS library on 18th December, 2024. The students participated and were informed about the importance of the day. The students were appreciated for their participation.

Symbiosis Medical college for Women, Pune had organized a **Blood donation camp** at AISSMS CHMCT. In all, 56 donors donated the blood. The donors included, Teaching, non-teaching and the students of AISSMS CHMCT. Preliminary examination and the Haemoglobin test was conducted and then the suitable donors were permitted for blood donation. The donors were given refreshments after the donation. The team from Symbiosis hospital in coordination with the NSS Unit coordinated very well. The initiative was praised by the Principal, Dr. Sonali Jadhav. The team of Symbiosis hospital provided college with an appreciation certificate.

River Cleaning - As per the circular NSS, SWO and Worship earth foundation together organized an event on 14th February, 2025 at Bhide bridge, nadipatra, Deccan, Pune. The drive focused on Environment sustainability, awareness about water pollution. The NSS volunteers reported at the venue at 7am. They participated in a rally focusing on river cleanliness. Volunteers also cleaned the surrounding area near Nadipatra and helped in cleanliness drive. The initiative was well appreciated and certificates were awarded to the participants.

As a part of NSS Activity of every year, this year also Special NSS winter camp was organized by the NSS unit of AISSMS CHMCT, Pune. under the guidance of Principal, Dr. Sonali Jadhav from, 18th December to 24th December, 2024 at Aandeshe gaon, Tal- Mulshi, and Dist- Pune- 05. The main aim of this special camp was to develop and implement the social service skills amongst the students and their duties and responsibilities towards the society.

It was seven days' residential camp. NSS Volunteers were worked hard for this camp. With the help of "NSS Special Camp" students attempted to take the message that we should serve our society and try to eliminate factor that are harmful for the society. The team of Sarpanch and Upsarpanch of the village closely coordinated and assisted all the activities and also appreciated the efforts taken by the NSS Unit during the camp. Following activities were conducted at the camp.

As per the circular received from SPPU and AICTE, NSS team and faculty of AISSMS CHMCT celebrated Shiv Jayanti Utsav at the campus of AISSMS CHMCT. The students came dressed in traditional attire. They visited the castles, drawings made by the AISSM Military school students. After the vandana, students also took part in the drice, “Jai Shivaji Jai Bharat”.

From darkness to hope

From 5% to 75% vision—Tulsi's world brightens after life-changing surgery

A 19-year-old girl from Mumbai, born with low vision and further injured by trauma to her eye, has been given a new lease of life after struggling for years without proper treatment. Tulsi Mahadev Jadhav, who lost her parents at a young age and now lives with her older sister Sumana Parne, underwent a successful eye surgery thanks to the efforts of a compassionate hospital management student and the support of legal and medical institutions.



Despite being a student with limited financial means, Arshina decided to take up Tulsi's case

health check-up camp conducted with Symbiosis Medical College. It was discovered that Tulsi's vision was rapidly deteriorating. She was at risk of losing her sight completely. I knew I had to do something," Arshina shared.

Services Authority (DLSA), Pune. The case was taken up under the Charitable Hospital Scheme as per the Maharashtra Public Trusts Act, 1960, which mandates that charitable hospitals allocate 2% of their billing for the treatment of indigent and economically weaker patients.

There, Dr. Akshay Kothari conducted a cataract surgery with lens implantation in late March. "She came to us with only 5% vision due to a complicated traumatic cataract. After the surgery, she now has 75% vision in the affected eye. Early diagnosis and timely action made all the difference," Dr. Kothari said.

"I never imagined I would see again. People used to tease me because of my eye. Now, I want to study and one day become a doctor to help others like me."

With help from DLSA Secretary Social Patti and in-house advocate Iqbal Kumar Abet, the case was swiftly processed. A letter was issued to the Joint Charity Commissioner Ragni Khosla and Deputy Commissioner Dr. Rajesh Parasheti, who coordinated the referral of Tulsi's case to the National Institute of Ophthalmology (NIO).

Her sister Sumana, overwhelmed with emotion, added, "Our parents are no longer with us, but I feel they sent angels in the form of Arshina and the team who helped Tulsi. I will make sure she gets every opportunity they couldn't give us."

Prof. Rajashree Patil, NSS Head at AISSMS CHMCT, expressed her pride in Arshina, stating, "I am glad and proud of Ms. Arshina Shaikh as she handled the situation of Ms. Tulsi's eye operations successfully and with full confidence by grace of god."

Her dedication is a testament to how young individuals can bring meaningful change. As education, we must nurture such compassion. As I always say—"Treat the world with support and spread happiness."

DLSA Secretary Social Patti echoed this sentiment, saying, "This case is a shining example of how law, compassion, and student activities can converge for the greater good."
